## RISE (Rising In Service for Education) Program

Online Only Small Groups organized by class. Optional for ALL students K-6 in either in-person or virtual class assignments.

- To give students the opportunity to safely connect with their classmates in an online small group setting.
- To give students the freedom (un-muted) to collaborate on asynchronous work or study with their peers.
- To give students an opportunity to socialize and have FUN together in a small group setting. Virtual games, read-alouds, or drawing to name a few activities worth exploring.
- To offer homework help and simple tutoring when resources are available.\*

Your child's Room Parent will coordinate the RISE program for your child's class. The schedule is completely flexible to each group's needs and availability. Groups will meet at least one hour per week any day of the week.
